473 B.C. by John Hulland (first published in 1974)

Only those rules which differ from the 1971 Diplomacy rule book are printed below.

1. The set up positions are: ROMA: A Rome, A Messina, F Naple  
CARTHAGE: A Carthage, F Hippo, F Zama  
GREECE: A Sparta, A Maceodnia, F Athens  
PERSIA: A Ephesus, F Issus, F Pergamum  
EGYPT: A Akhenaton, F Memphis, F Tyre
2. The first year of play is 473 B.C. and each "season" after that is one year (e.g. Spring 1901 corresponds to 473, Fall to 472 etc.)
3. The Greek player cannot build a fleet in Sparta until 468 B.C.
4. The two areas marked "Mid Atlantic Ocean" or M.A.O. are one space.
5. There are 28 supply centers on the board. A player must have 15 or more units on board at the end of a build year in order to win.
