1. Standard (1971) Diplomacy rules followed except where otherwise stated.
2. The regular Diplomacy board is used with the additions and alterations as shown on the map.
3. There are 2 new powers: Barbary States and Persia. Barbary begins with A(Alg) F(Mor) F(Tun). Persia begins with A(Irq) A(Irn) F(Jor)wc. In addition, the starting places for the Turkish units are: A(Con) F(Smy) F(Ank).
4. In addition to the new home provinces in rule 3, the following neutral centres are added: Piedmont, Corsica, Canary Islands, Ethiopia, Egypt, Crete. The total centres becomes 45.
5. Canals.
  - A. Kiel Canal, Dardanelles, Denmark - operate as usual.
  - B. Suez Canal. Passes through the 'middle' of Egypt, i.e. severing the Sinai from Egypt proper. It operates precisely as does the Dardanelles, i.e. an army may move through Egypt without concern for the canal, a fleet may move through Suez via Egypt.
  - C. Volga Canal. This is a major change. A fleet may move from the Black Sea to the Caspian and vice-versa. Fleets may be built in Moscow. Iran has two coasts. Movement along the Volga Canal disregards entirely the land provinces en route. A fleet moves Caspian - Volga - Black Sea, or v.v. i.e. the Volga is in effect a sea province; however, armies may move freely across the canal even while a fleet is occupying it, and fleets are not affected by the armies moving around it. The canal is a one-move jump; that is, it is not segmented by the land boundaries in the middle of it. Convoys are not allowed by fleets in the canal.
6. Off Board Box.  
There is an Off Board Box(OBB) between the provinces WAO and INO. No convoys may be made via this route. A fleet 'rounding the cape' moves off the board for one turn i.e. F(WAO)-OBB. Next turn, F(OBB)-INO, or vice-versa. Fleets stationed off board are(except for convoying) fully operative; they may support or be supported. ((Interpretation:- only one fleet at a time may occupy the OBB and is liable to attack from WAO or INO)).
7. Clarifications.  
The following moves(and their vice-versas) are all legal.  
F(SAO)-WMS ForA(Mor)-Spa F(LOS)-TYS A(Sev)-Geo A(Mos)-Arn
