**COLONIA VII**

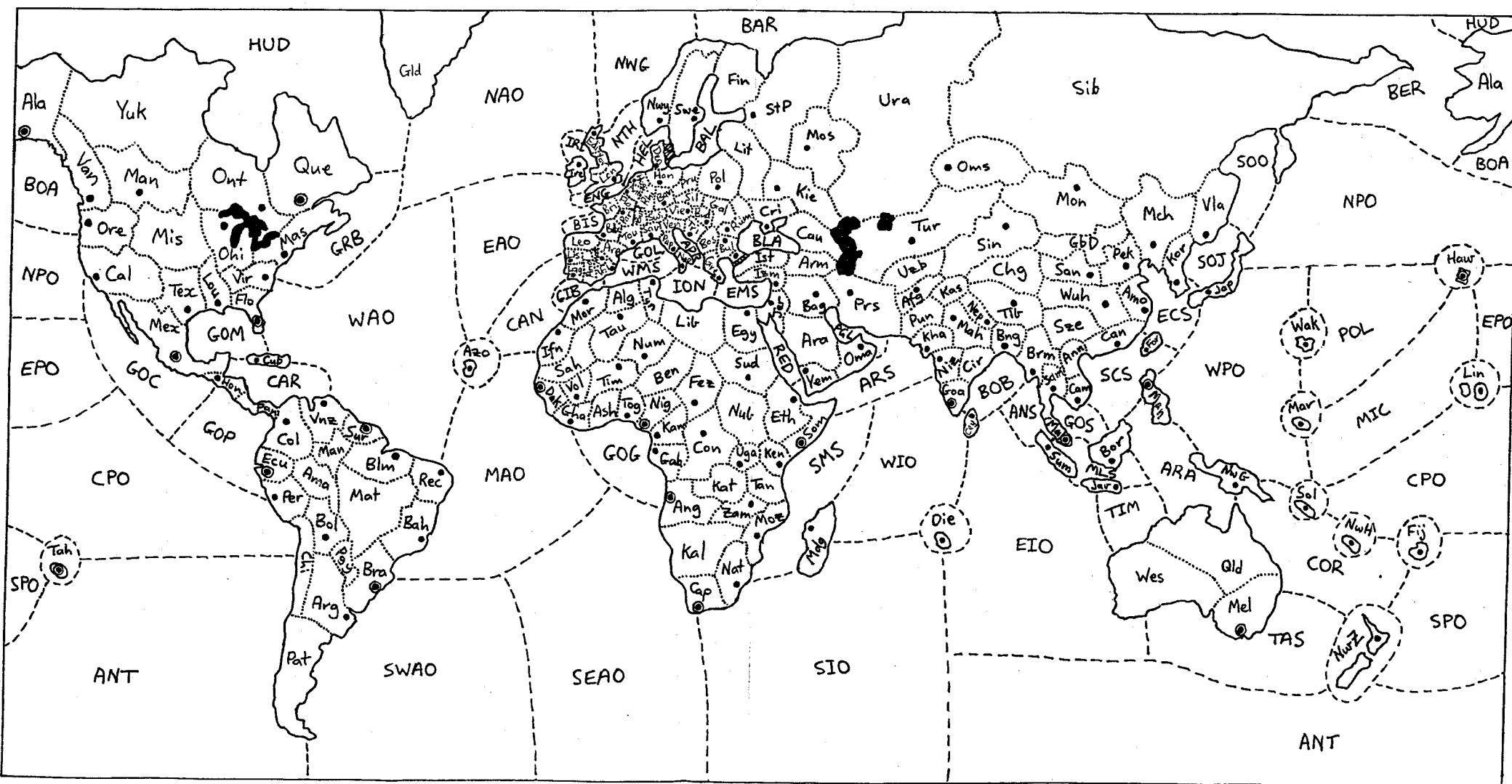
Rules by Fred G. Hyatt.

- The rules of the standard 1982 North American Diplomacy rule book apply, except where modified below.
- The Powers and starting positions are:  
AUSTRIA: A Vienna, A Budapest, A Florida, F Trieste, F Hawaii.  
CHINA: A Peking, A Sian, A Wuhan, F Amoy.  
ENGLAND: A Ecuador, A Nigeria, A Malaya, F London, F Edinburgh.  
FRANCE: A Paris, A Toulon, A Quebec, A Dakar, F Bordeaux.  
NETHERLANDS: A Antwerp, A Surinam, A Angola, A Goa, F Hague.  
OTTOMAN: A Izmir, A Jerusalem, A Baghdad, A Brazil, F Istanbul.  
PORTUGAL: A Lagos, A Alaska, A Cape Colony, F Lisbon, F Melbourne.  
RUSSIA: A Moscow, A Omsk, A Kiev, F St. Petersburg (sc), F Tahiti, F Uladivostok.  
SPAIN: A Madrid, A Mexico, A Somalia, F Valencia, F Manila.
- Note that the provinces on the eastern most edge of the map are the same as those on the western most edge. Thus a fleet could move from Denmark Sea to South Pacific to ~~Peru~~ CPO, and so forth.
- Those islands which are neutral supply centres, as well as those which are Island Colonies, may be occupied by an army. An army dislodged from an island may retreat to another island or a mainland province via fleet convoy provided there is a fleet available to make the convoy and that the convoy retreat does not exceed one sea-space. The retreating army and the convoying fleet must be of the same nationality. This rule applies only to armies dislodged from island centres. For the purposes of this rule, Britain and Australia are considered to be mainlands.
- There are certain supply centres which are "colonies". Colonies are building supply centres for whichever Power controls them. They begin under the control of the Power with starting units placed there. The colonies are: Alaska, Quebec, Florida, Mexico, Ecuador, Surinam, Brazil, Dakar, Nigeria, Angola, Cape Colony, Somalia, Malaya, Goa, Manila, Hawaii, Melbourne and Tahiti.
- There are three "special supply centres" which may be used for building purposes by specific Powers. The centres and Powers are: Crimea - Russia and Ottoman; Naples - Austria and Spain; Canton - China. The centres may be used for building only after being occupied. For all other Powers, these centres function as neutral supply centres.
- The Arctic Ocean and Antarctica are impassable and are not marked on the map.
- The Arctic (northern) coast of Siberia is passable to fleets.
- A victory shall consist of ownership of fifty (50) supply centres or by concession vote. In order for a concession proposal to pass, the proposal must carry by a Three-Fourths (3/4) majority of all supply centres, excluding centres which are neutral or owned by a Power in civil disorder. Thus, with all supply centres occupied, Powers controlling Ninety-Nine (99) centres can end the game by voting to do so. A concession proposal can be for any combination of drawing, winning and/or placings.
