I'll keep running this advert below until the games are finished - you never know SOMEONE might see it.

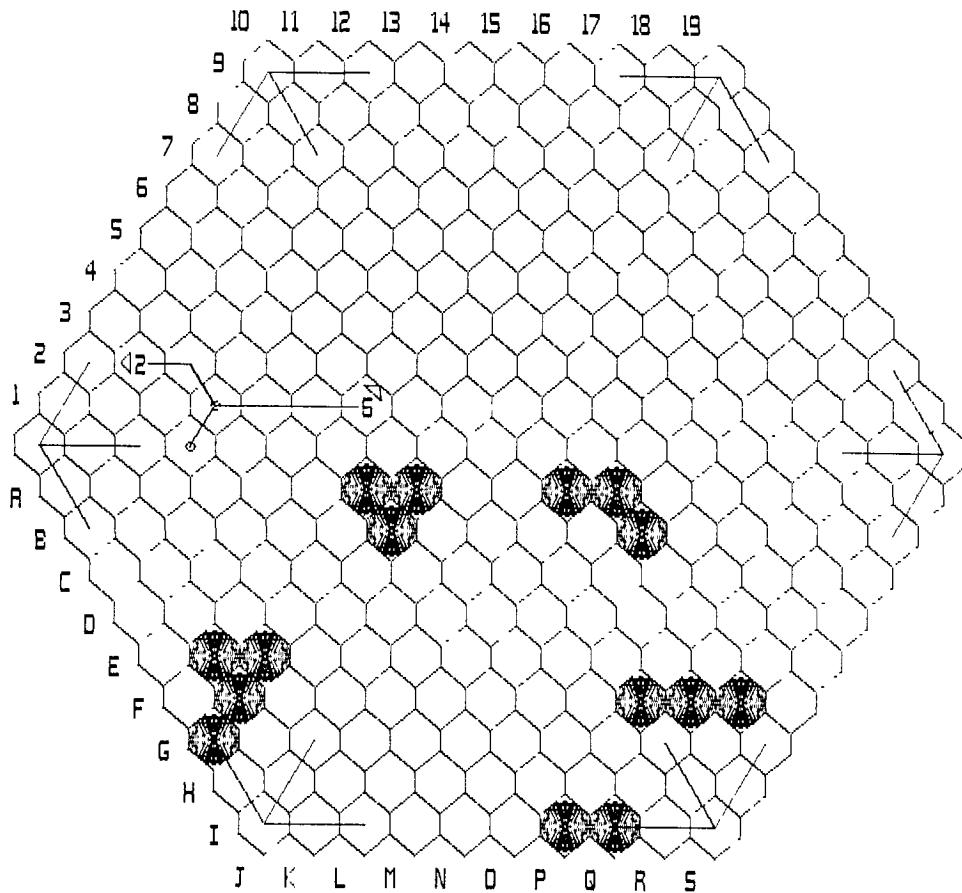

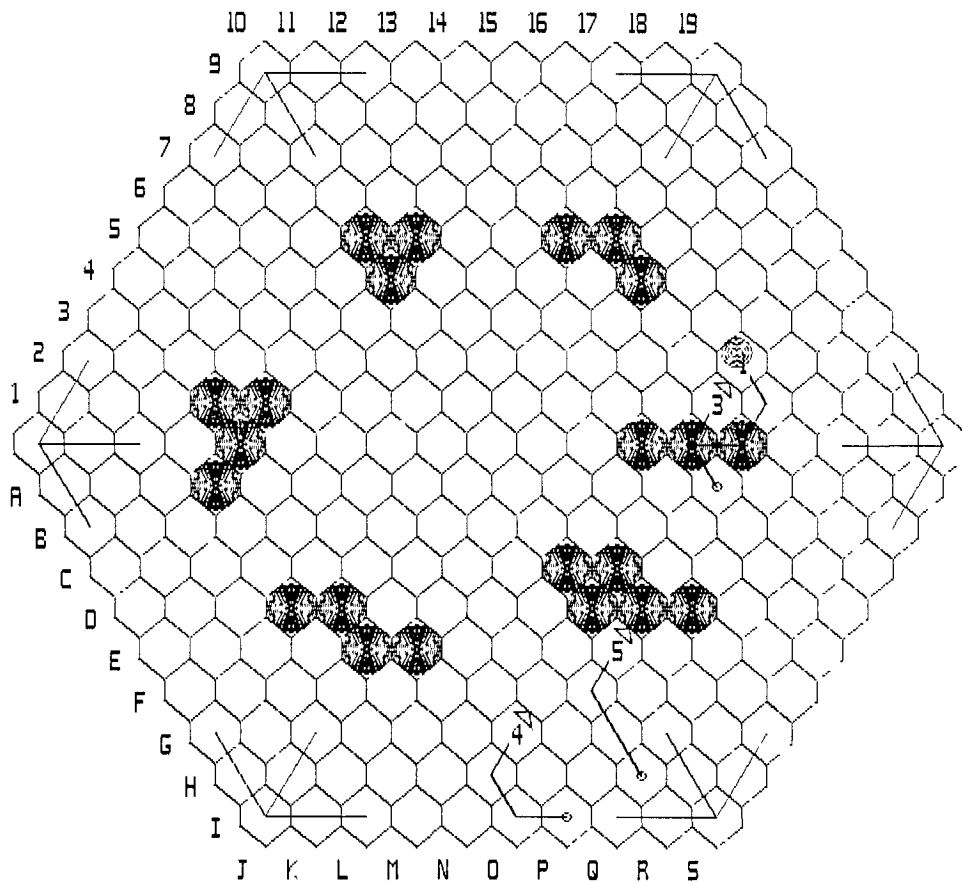
