Diplomacy Waiting List: Jed Stone - you don't worry me y'know, Jed, with my subscriber list there is no way these games can happen!

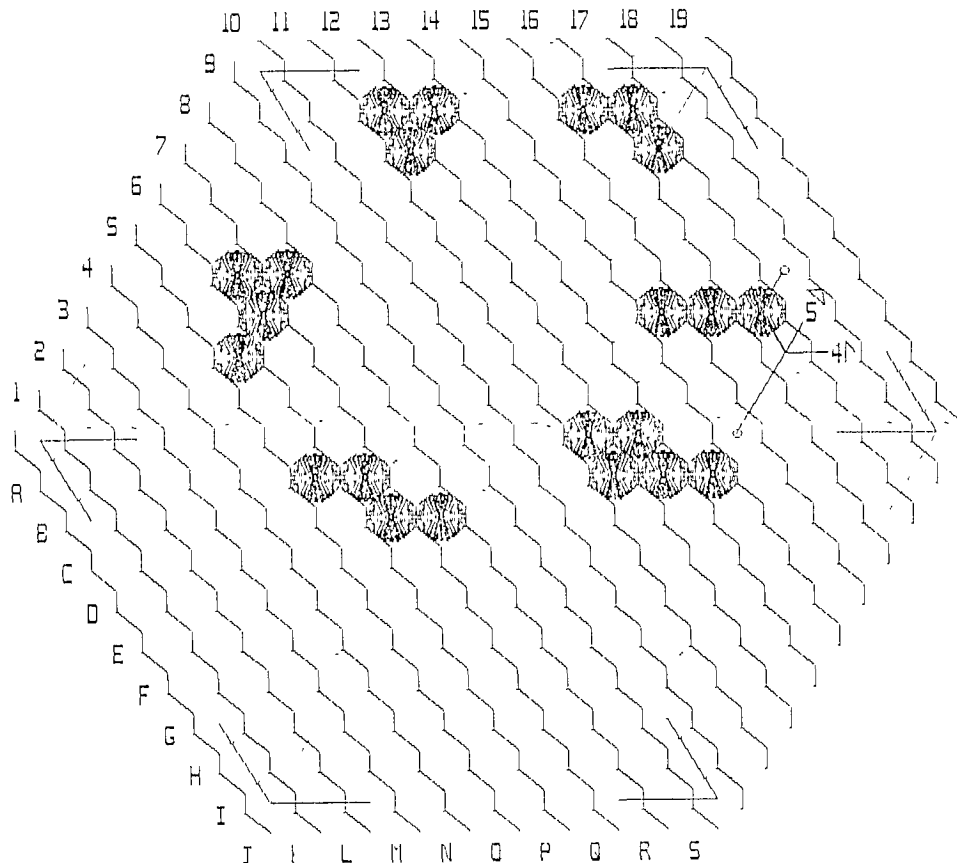
