Move 2 & 3 Nothing of interest happened.

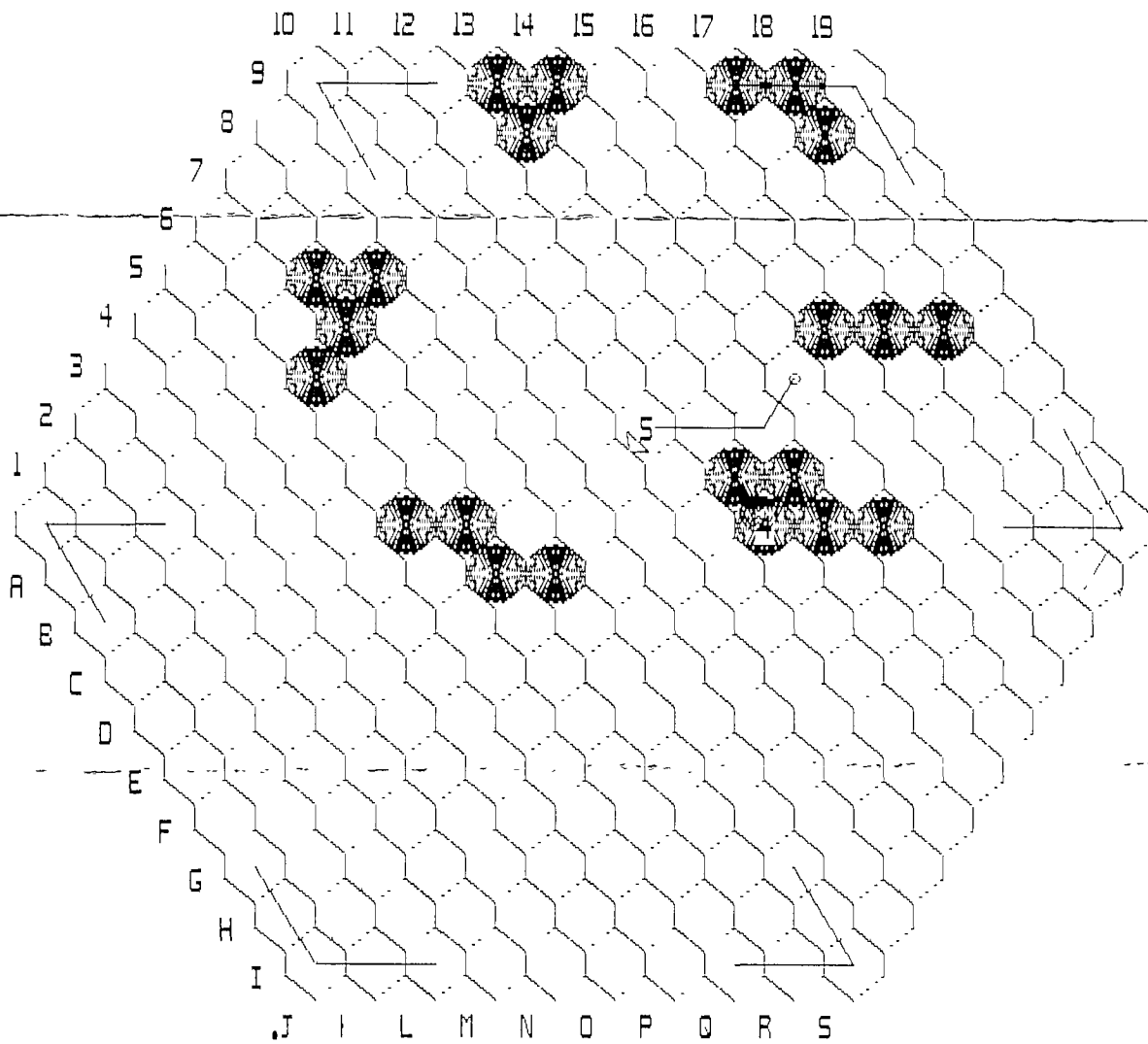
