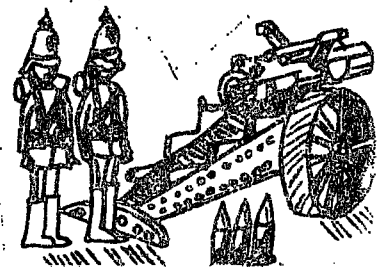
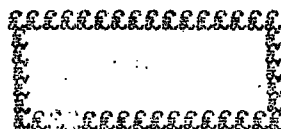
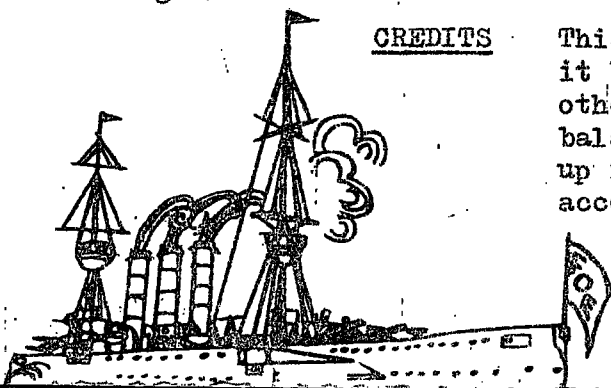
EDITORIAL

Welcome to the ninetieth issue of Fall of Eagles - a pale shadow of the 89 forerunners. This is the first photocopied issue since issue 8. It is the smallest issue since issue 1, and it has the smallest circulation ever. Only six of you are receiving copies, I wonder if it will have a rarity value in the years to come? The recipients are the four remaining players in the FOE 48, Richard Walkerdine for the archives, and one lone subscriber in Steve Jones who has expressed his willingness to receive the single sheet FOE 48 reports.

You'll see from above that I have set a deadline of March 6th - a normal 4 week deadline. However, as it seems very likely indeed that the game will end next season, I intend adjudicating as soon as I receive 4 sets of orders - and bear in mind that I have two sets of standing orders for that game. If the game does not end then you will hear as soon as possible (ie after I have 4 sets of orders, or after the deadline has passed). I intend putting out a reasonable length last issue of FOE including the FOE 48 final season and game-end report among other things.
