 OF PARIS TO THE TATTERED REMNANTS OF A ONCE-GLORIOUS ITALIAN ARMY; BUT  
 POINTS OUT THAT THE PREVIOUS GOVERNMENT HAD MORE THAN PROVED ITS  
 INCOMPETANCE, AND WILL BE NO LOSS TO FRANCE.

"THEY COULDN'T DEFEND THEIR VIRGINITY FROM A RANDY FIVE-YEAR-OLD"  
 HE IS REPORTED TO HAVE SAID, IN PRIVATE COMPANY.

[THE MARSHAL IS WELL-KNOWN FOR HIS PREVIOUS ASSAULT ON MUNICH, WHEN

BRITAIN'S FLEET IN KEIL RETREATS  
 TO HEL AS ORDERED  
 AUSTRIA-HUNGARY'S BULGARIAN FLEET  
 RETREATS TO GREECE - ONLY ONE

CONTINUED:

NINE DREADNAUGHTS, SEVENTEEN CRUISERS AND SEVENTEEN TORPEDO-BOAT DESTROYERS WERE DELIBERATELY SCUTTLED IN THE THAMES ESTUARY TO BLOCK IT TO BRITISH SHIPPING. THE SUCCESS OF THE RAID CAN BE SEEN BY THE COMPLETE PARALYSIS OF THE BRITISH FORCES THIS AUTUMN. IT IS REGRETFULLY CONSIDERED THAT THE TYRANT IS NOT BELIEVED TO HAVE BEEN KILLED IN THE BOMBARDMENT. OVER 30,000 WORKMEN IN THE NEWLY LIBERATED PART OF BREST HAVE GLADLY VOLUNTERED AS DOCKYARD REPAIR MEN TO GIVE THE RETURNING FLEET A SUTABLE JOYOUS RECEPTION ON ITS RETURN TO ITS HOME BASE. THE FRENCH MILITARY GAINED YET ANOTHER SUCCESS IN THE SOUTH, WHEN IN A SUPERB DEMONSTRATION OF STRATEGY, THE SOUTHERN ARMY SEVERED THE ITALIAN LINES OF COMMUNICATION.
