'D' Game (1971BU) Autumn 1902

- I: In an audience with the Pope in Rome today the title of 'Holy Roman Emperor' was conferred on the King of Italy, Umberto the Pious. The Emperor's first pledge following the coronation was to free Europe from tyranny and oppression.
- R: Let it be known that Holy Russia is now in a state of war with the Germanic peoples of central Europe. The attempt by Germany supported by the devilish Englanders to occupy Sweden will bring down the righteous wrath of the Czar upon the Kaiser. If Germany apologises and hands over Denmark, Berlin and Munich to Russia as compensation, the Czar may consider making peace. If not, then let Germany fall!
- T: The Byzantine Emperor has attended a display of aerobatic skill given by the Imperial Flying Corps. These machines will be invaluable for reconnaissance and espionage work. When not in use they roll up and can be conveniently carried under the arms, and they provide an instant disguise for Turkish agents, who will now masquerade as carpet salesman.
- GB: In view of the recent attacks by French forces on the neutral country of Belgium, HM Government issued an ultimatum to the French Cabinet. We have received no official answer - although a heavily accented voice shouted 'Merde' down the hot line last night. - GB: 5 bases: 3 Britain, Nor, Bel. No change.
- G: 6 bases: 3 Germany, Hol, Den, Swe. Builds A Ber.
- R: 6 bases: 4 Russia, Rum, Bud. No change.
- T: 6 bases: 3 Turkey, Gre, Bul, Ser. Builds A Con.
- I: 6 bases: 3 Italy, Vie, Tri, Tun. Builds F Nap, A Ven.
- F: 5 bases: 3 France, Por, Spa. No change.
