New Rulebook

From Erehwon 52 comes news that the new rulebook is now finished and is in the hands of the US manufacturers of Diplomacy, Games Research.

This new edition has been drawn up by the game's original inventor, Allan Calhmer. It incorporates the experience gained from the hundreds of postal and across-the-table games that have been recorded. To quote from Erehwon:

'The outstanding new feature of the Rulebook is its organisation. Each section and subsection is numbered so that reference to the text will be much easier. Also included are over a dozen numbered examples of movement sequences illustrating some of the more knotty rules.'

'The most striking change is the victory criterion. It is 18 supply centers. That's right!... This is probably the most fundamental change in the rules...'

The new rulebook will I understand be available seperately from the game. Games Research have expressed their willingness to distribute copies to postal GMs. I doubt if there will be an English edition, at least not for some time - if anyone would like a copy please ask and I'll try and obtain some when they are available.

It is, of course, nothing of the sort. The British bulldog could see off the French cockerel with one hand behind his back any day of the week. Looking at the continent of Europe, swarming as it is with swarthy Turks, greasy Italians, sub-human Slavs and Eluan's wine-sodden minions, can anyone doubt that the future belongs to the pan-Teutonic union?

I: The peace-loving government of the Holy Roman Empire has found itself forced into a war with the Sultan of Turkey due to the aggressive expansion of the Turks in the Balkans.
